A - Shown here is the first version for the client to review. At this point the preliminary vehicle and aircraft art had been accepted. However, the woman wearing a flaming swimsuit was deemed as 'too risqué'. The director did not think her 'check out my flames' pose was appropriate. She was edited out and coloring began.

B & C- Sometimes the graphics are drawn in place along with the car and aircraft. That was the protocol for these two pieces. As the projects continued there were many more text bits and graphic elements added. I show the B+W line art as it was just prior to those embellishments. The client requested I repurpose the same airplane for two years running. To save time I also reused the Mt. Hood art too! The car art turned out super cool IMO.

D - One of my favorites. The classic Cadillac with fins parked under the swept wings of a jet. What could be more in keeping with the theme than being at a drive-in?
