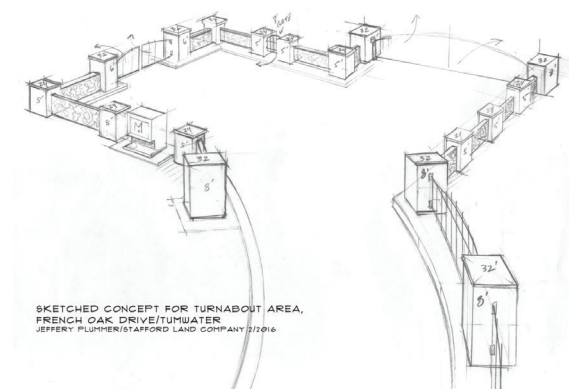

MONUMENT & ARCHITECTURAL SIGNS

A - In preparation for the 2016 NW Natural Street of Dreams event at Tumwater there was a matter of designing the entry. Gordon and I walked the dirt with a can of upside down paint to mark where the walls and posts should be. Then back at the office I drew up the sketch (shown here) that was followed by stone masons and gate installation contractors.

To complete the feel of elegance I designed several cast bronze plaques for installation into the columns.

B - The **Quintessence** show home required a sign that embodied the home it represented. Every home needs an address, right? I designed that into the monument along with the story of what Quintessence means.

C - The new **Fox Glen** entrance was designed with a rusted patina finish over split face stone to endure for decades to come. (B & C installation and metal fabrication by Dean McKee / Oregon Metal Fabrication)
